**Footnotes**

MUCH TOO MUCH argued the pace early while down along the rail, continued to scrimmage for the lead still along the rail down the backside, took the lead at the half mile pole, held a clear lead on the turn and maintained a clear advantage late. KIPLING tracked the leaders three wide early, made a bid for the lead two wide on the last turn, swung out four wide into the stretch and finished gamely late. NATALIS (IRE) well back early, circled the field four wide on the last turn and flattened out late. NICE APPEAL dueled for command three wide early, was close to the pace still three wide down the backstretch, and weakened on turn. LIGHT BAGGAGE chased the leaders early along the rail and made no impact. RAY'S FUTURE dueled for the lead off the rail early dropped back at the half mile pole and retired on the far turn.
