SO HAPPY TOGETHER broke a step slow, settled into stride toward mid track, rallied four wide into the final turn, dueled to the lead approaching the eighth pole then widened with steady encouragement. FRANSCAT rated just off the pace inside, advanced off the rail through the final turn then continued in a slow steady approach to get place the final yards. FIRST INTERVIEW rated off the early pace about the four path, advanced to a short lead approaching the final turn, contested through the upper stretch then weakened from the eighth pole. SKIP'S SINGER rated back toward mid track, bid into the final turn and finished evenly. LUSI POND rated off the early pace inside, bid mildly entering the stretch then leveled off. E MAIL PAT, unhurried off the rail, made a mild middle bid into the final turn then flattened stride. TOP HILL saved ground early and was outrun. EXIST set the early pace inside, gave chase into the final turn then faded through the turn. QUITE AN ANGEL rated close to the early pace about the three path while between horses and gave way nearing the final turn.
