Breeders' Cup money also correspondingly divided providing a Breeders' Cup nominee has finished in an awarded position. Any Breeders' Cup money not awarded will revert to the Fund. Weight: 121 lbs. Non-winners of a Graded Stake at a mile or over in 2004 allowed 3 lbs.; \$60,000 in 2004, 6 lbs. Breeders' Cup Limited will present a trophy to the winning owner. Closed Sunday, August 1, 2004 with 18 nominations.

CAPESIDE LADY rated the pace inside, was urged clear entering the stretch then widened with a mostly hand ride. HOPELESSLY DEVOTED, unhurriedly, started her drive outside into the final turn, reached place an eighth out and proved best of the rest. HABIBOO rated just off the pace about the four path, made her bid entering the stretch, drifted slightly in and leveled off. ENDER'S SISTER made light contact with Rings And Things entering the opening turn, was kept just off the pace in the three path, began her push into the final turn then weakened from the furlong pole. RINGS AND THINGS broke awkwardly, made light contact with Ender's Sister into the opening turn, rated just off the pace toward the inside, angled out into the final turn then weakened outside. PILFER rated close just off the rail, picked up the chase into the final turn the faded through the turn.
