Footnotes

CLASSIC EXAMPLE rated just off the pace in the three path, split horses approaching the furlong pole, drew clear leaving there and finished willingly with only moderate encouragement. DIAVLA was a step slow on the break then unsettled the opening strides, waited unhurriedly inside, lacked room on the rail nearing the quarter pole, came through the same hole as the winner in midstretch, was too late to catch that one but dueled for place. SIMPLY PERFECT rated back toward the outside, bid eight wide nearing the quarter pole, closed with the runner up but was outfinished for place. EDISON LANES rated a short lead off the rail, edged clear on the final turn, wavered a bit through the upper stretch then faded the last furlong. GIPSY LIMITS was kept close to the early pace just off the rail, picked up the chase through the final turn, was steadied in tight on the rail in midstretch then weakened. MOON FEATHER rated off the pace outside, was seven wide through the final turn then weakened. WORLDLINESS rated close in the three path, remained a factor through the upper stretch then weakened with a furlong to go. IMPETUOUS SEA showed no speed then no rally. RISQUE CENTERFOLD showed no speed inside then no rally.
