JENNY BEAN GIRL prompted the pace down the backstretch between rivals, reached the front on the final turn and raced just off the rail turning for home while battling for command then responded gamely to prevail. LUCKY REVIVAL prompted the pace down the backstretch three deep, reached the front outside the top one nearing the quarter pole, dueled through the lane then was outfinished. SHERUNSOFORBILLY saved ground into the far turn, eased off the inside and raced four wide into the lane, loomed a threat but was not good enough. MY FAIR EL set the early pace, saved ground and remained a factor until nearing the top of the lane and weakened. BIANCO moved up four wide on the final turn and loomed a solid threat then raced out in the strip into the lane and was eased and walked off .
