**Footnotes**

BELLE OF CAMDEN three deep early, pressed outside and finished well while drawing clear. TOWN GLORY vied for the lead inside and was no match late. CODE LEGAL raced off the inside turning for home and offered a late gain. WILDANDFABULOUS four wide into the turn, raced close up outside and lacked the needed response. SUPER CHILD stumbled at the start and trailed, was angled in in upper stretch and lacked the needed rally. SO MUCH TROUBLE vied early between rivals, could not keep pace on the turn and tired through the lane.
