CUSTER saved ground early and between rivals briefly into the far turn, raced outside into the lane and finished gamely to prevail. PLENTY COUPS tracked early and moved to the front approaching the far turn, drew clear and widened some in midstretch then yielded late. CLASSIC CAMPAIGN saved ground to the lane, eased out and gained some late. DUVEEN just a bit reluctant to load, raced well placed outside, lodged a three wide bid on the final turn and lacked the needed late response. LITTLE DOVEFEATHER raced near the rail into the far turn and lacked the needed rally. VICTORY ALLEGED trailed early, raced four wide turning for home and lacked a rally. OBJECTIVE raced off the inside into the far turn and lacked a rally. CABLE BOY in a bit close at the start, set the early pace, saved ground and weakened nearing the lane.
