SURLY SUE prompted the early issue, moved to the front turning for home and drew clear leaving the furlong grounds then held JUDGE'S SONG safe in the run to the wire. JUDGE'S SONG a bit slow into stride, advanced between rivals through the early stages and reached the front, saved ground then moved out some after being displaced during the stretch run and continued on willingly. CALLADA advanced between foes entering the turn, raced off the rail into the lane and was gaining some late. E BAR EL stumbled at the start, raced well placed early from the outside, was asked nearing the top of the lane then weakened in the drive. MERLOT MOMENT saved ground and lacked the needed stretch response. OLIVIA JO saved ground while close up early and tired through the lane. SONOITA SUNSET stumbled at the break and lacked a bid. SUNDAY SPORT raced five wide turning for home and flattened out. IT'S THE TRUTH dropped back on the turn and faded through the stretch.
