CASSIDY'S CODE well back in the early stages, made a bid for the lead four wide on the last turn, entered the stretch in the same path, had the leader in her sights at the furlong pole and reeled her in the final 100 yards. ELEGANT APRIL was the controlling speed from the start, held a clear advantage into the stretch and weakened slightly late. UNKNOWN SPIRIT chased along the rail early, made a bid for the lead three wide on the last turn, entered the stretch five wide and finished with good energy. MEADOW SUNRISE stalked the leaders three wide early, was asked for her best around the final turn while still wide and flattened out late. BRIELLE outran along the inside, gather momentum way too late. KYLEY'S MOON chased off the rail early, was asked for his best two wide on the last turn and tired in the late stages. TALINUM DRIVE outran and passed tired rivals. KLEARLEE KIERA chased along the inside and was no factor. SKOUT ABOUT was a forward factor along the inside early, tired on the last turn and was outdistanced.
