HIGH LADY raced unhurriedly while not far back, angled five wide making her bid on the far turn, had a steady advance to late stretch and was clear in the final yards. DELIRIO rated the pace, remained clear under a drive to the sixteenth pole then was outfinished in the final yards. TIFFISH was rated just off the pace toward the inside, came to the outside of the pacesetter in midstretch making her bid but lacked a late response. PURRFECT PUNCH was jostled and shuffled back early then ran off the pace, made a four wide bid on the far turn then was empty in the stretch. ISBELL AMBIEL was rated close to the pace, ran evenly while between horses on the far turn then steadied angling to the inside at the top of the stretch and weakened. PRINCESS HA HA lost some ground entering the first turn the was kept off the pace, saved ground through the far turn and offered no rally. OUR SAYDEE was no factor.
