TO MARQUET showed the way to the lane, widened some into midstretch then maintained a safe margin to the wire. MARY'S NICKLE trailed early, advanced between rivals in midstretch then closed well late along the inside. CITY FAIR well placed and four wide into the lane, responded in the drive but was not good enough. ASTRID between rivals into the turn, chased the leader from the three path and lacked the needed late response. TRUE ROSE raced off the rail on the turn and lacked a rally. TUGGER hesitated some leaving the gate, raced outside and lacked a response in a dull effort. A. P. ANDIE pressed the early issue, saved ground and weakened. LOOK OF THE LYNX a bit sluggish at the start, advanced inside, raced outside a rival on the turn and tired through the lane.
