DROP THE GUN was climbing early, settled off the pace, rallied five wide past the quarter pole and finished well outside for the win. COOL COLONY set the pace on the inside, took back passing the half mile marker, re bid four wide at the quarter pole and came up second best. JOEY TOMATO raced off the pace, made a four wide middle move into contention on the backside, dueled three wide on the far turn and weakened. MEATBEAU raced off the pace and bested the others. SHOUTOUT did not factor. PERFECT MAN vied in the two path, dueled inside on the far turn and faded. OUR NINO vied three wide on the backside, dueled between on the turn and faded.
