### Footnotes

SHOOTER a bit reluctant to load, broke alertly, challenged for the lead on the turn, lugged in slightly leaving the furlong grounds then finished determinedly to prevail. SNOW RIDGE a bit fractious in the gate, saved ground while close up, stayed on the rail for the drive and joined the leaders in midstretch then finished gamely. T P LOUIE posted the early fractions, raced just off the rail and responded well in the drive then weakened late. STARBURY broke a bit slowly, raced outside and lacked a rally. WALTZ KING well placed early from the outside, had little left for the drive. DUALITY stumbled at the start, advanced some inside on the turn then tired through the lane. HIGH IDEAL between rivals into the turn, gave way rounding the bend and was not urged through the stretch.
