CHANTEL D chased the pace and weakened in the drive. ON A WHIRL advanced outside into the turn, loomed a threat into upper stretch and tired. PRECIOUS TEMPER well placed early, saved ground on the turn and weakened. WHERE'S ME GOING lacked a rally. HARDY HAR HAR ducked into the gap soon after the start, raced outside on the turn and lacked a stretch response. VINTAGE PUNCH was through early. JAZZ GODDESS broke slowly then failed to menace.
