Footnotes

HOTTENTOT close up early while saving ground, eased out on the final turn, advanced into the lane and reached the front a furlong out then drew clear while being ridden out. E MAIL PAT saved ground early, moved out for the drive and finished well for the place. SHE DID IT HER WAY prompted the early issue, moved to the lead on the final turn, battled into midstretch then just failed to hold the place. TALKIN' KIND saved ground and lacked the needed stretch response. ASPEN FLOWER lodged a bid outside on the final turn and lacked the needed late response. IMPRESS ME raced well placed into the far turn and weakened. CHLOE POND set the early pace, saved ground and weakened. KRISANA broke a bit slowly then angled over, raced outside a rival early and lacked a rally.
