TEDDY BALLGAME broke slowly and trailed early, advanced rounding the final turn and finished gamely to prevail. KING'S CORONATION well placed early, moved closer turning for home and reached the front in the stretch then continued on gamely to the wire while unable to resist the top one. MAD BOB CAT set the pace inside and weakened in the drive while holding a share. NETWORK raced near the inside turning for home and lacked a solid bid. AMERICAN FREEDOM raced near the rail into the far turn and lacked the needed response. JOHN'S SONG tracked early, saved ground to the lane and weakened in the drive. EL APACHE raced outside a rival into the far turn, lacked a bid then tired through the lane. ADDEMUP fractious at the gate, lacked a response and had little left turning for home.
