ITSAGOODTENDOLLARS raced four wide early, chased outside, moved up on the backside to challenge, dueled with HUNG JURY on the far turn, continued to battle it out past midstretch and prevailed late. HUNG JURY set the pace on the inside, dueled with the winner and dug in gamely to the finish. JERSEY KISS was outrun early, came three wide into the lane, rallied outside and was gaining late. MAGICAL MYTH was bumped at the start, raced four wide early, pulled on the first turn, made a middle move into contention, chased on the far turn and weakened. BLUEMBER raced four wide early, three wide on the far turn and lacked a rally. KING HENRY was bumped at the start, chased between rivals and tired. MARQUET REBEL was steadied on the first turn, chased inside and tired. FIFTY SENSE chased between foes, gave way and stopped.
