**Footnotes**

L. B. ON TOUR was in close attendance to the pacemakers early along the three path, made a swift move for the lead entering the far turn, took the lead in hand on the turn and drew clear under mild urging in the final furlong. BRUSHED ON set the early pace along the inside early, was hooked on the final turn by the winner, lost the lead midway on the turn and was not good enough but was the best of the balance. RUDIRUDY chased along the rail early, was roused on the final turn along the inside, had dead aim on the leaders entering the stretch and ran evenly in the final furlong. ROLL AGAIN was wrestled back early, showed little early speed, made a bid for the lead along the rail on the final turn, weaved his way through traffic and finished up very well in the final furlong. I CLAUDIUS stalked four wide early, made a bid for the lead three wide on the last turn, and came up empty in the final furlong. IT'S ONLY MONEY broke a bit slowly, was chased four wide early, made a bid for the lead three wide on the last turn and failed to fire late. SOUTHERN BOSTONION was outrun early and was no factor. ROY'S RUCKUS was a forward factor early and retired on the last turn.
