NOVEMBER SUNSET showed no early speed along the inside early, rallied around the final turn, entered the stretch six wide, took the lead inside the furlong pole and drew clear. INTRIGUING ANGLE set the pace early, held a clear lead on the final turn and was overtaken in the final furlong. IN THE RAIN chased four wide early, made a bid for the lead along the inside on the last turn and finished well late. SENOR PUDDLES stalked off the rail early, was motivated to keep pace along the backside, was under an all out drive on the last turn and was outfinished for the show spot late. KING MIO ROYAL chased three wide early, was roused on the backside to keep pace and retired on the last turn. JUDGELorenZO chased and tired. THUNDERING STORM chased off the rail and was no threat. DANCING DEMON was a brief pace factor.
