AFTERNOON TREAT always a factor, moved to the front entering the lane and drew clear then held to the wire. JERSEY KISS never far back and three wide passing the quarter pole, finished gamely. BROKEN TRAIL chased on the turn, was along the inside into the lane and lacked the needed late response. MUMBO broke a bit slowly, raced near the rail on the turn and lacked the needed stretch bid. CLOSE TO COLTEN raced outside on the turn and lacked the needed rally. P J'S BACK vied for the early lead, raced along the inside turning for home and tired in the drive. HAV'N A FOG ATTACK trailed early and lacked a rally. FOURLEAF STREET raced outside into the turn and lacked a bid. MANHATTAN PHIL lacked a response. WILD DIXIE CAT moved up inside through the early stages and vied for the lead into the turn then gradually weakened.
