HARISSA up close early from the outside, moved to the front nearing the quarter pole then was under mild hand urging while drawing clear leaving the furlong grounds. DEBONAIR DARLING set the early pace, saved ground into the lane and was no match to the top one while second best. QUIET HOPE well placed and near the rail, raced in the three path into the lane and lacked the needed bid. ALL BETS OFF trailed early, saved ground and lacked the needed rally. VERY SWEET moved outside on the clubhouse turn, raced within striking distanced to the far turn and came up empty. MONEIGH LISA tracked early, saved ground and weakened through the lane. HIT IT RICH stumbled at the start then steadied on the clubhouse turn and rank briefly, raced just off the inside into the far turn and lacked a response.
