### Footnotes

THEN SHE LAUGHS pressured the pace two deep, raced alongside the pacesetter through the turn, dueled with a slight advantage through the upper stretch then gradually edged clear with steady encouragement. FORTY MOVES rated off the pace outside, improved her position widest on the turn, was under a solid drive to reach place but couldn't threaten the winner. ABSOLUTE NECTAR rated a pressured pace inside, continued dueling through the upper stretch but yielded the final furlong. FRENCHGLEN rated close in the four path, was shuffled back entering the stretch and had nothing left afterward. HUMOR ME MOLLY chased the pace from the three path, angled out toward midstretch then leveled off. SLEWVILLE was unsettled the opening strides, remained boxed in to the top of the stretch, angled out for the drive but had no rally.
