INDIAN WAR DANCE set the pace near the rail, responded gamely when asked then maintained a safe margin. MEADOW BLUE close up early, saved ground to the lane and finished willingly. EL CHILE DOG raced along the inside turning for home and offered a mild stretch bid. MOUNT WILTON broke a bit slowly, raced close up outside and lacked the needed response. FRENCH TRANSITION tracked early and weakened on the final turn. LIGHT WRAP trailed while not far back, raced four wide into the lane and lacked a rally.
