FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$200 each, which should accompany the nomination and \$2,500 to pass the entry box with \$300,000 guaranteed, which includes \$100,000 from the Breeders' Cup Fund for Cup nominees only. The host association's money to be divided 60% to the winning owner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Breeders' Cup Fund money correspondingly divided provided a Breeders' Cup nominee finishes in an awarded position. Any Breeders' Cup money not awarded reverts to the Fund. Three-Year-Olds: 118 lbs.; Older: 123 lbs. Non-winners of \$90,000 twice at a mile or over since November 1 allowed 2 lbs.; A graded stake at a mile or over in 2009, 4 lbs.; \$45,000 at a mile or over since May 1, 2009, 6 lbs. The owner of the winner to receive a trophy presented by Breeders' Cup Limited. Monmouth Park and the Graded Stakes Committee require steroid testing on all graded stakes races. Closed Saturday, August 8, 2009 with 10 nominations.

CHIRAC was away alertly, set the pace on the inside, responded when asked turning for home, drew away and widened under urging. YOU AND I FOREVER saved ground racing off the pace, moved up between rivals on the far turn, rallied three wide into the stretch and came up second best. PAMPERED SIR pressed the pace, chased on the turn and weakened in the final furlong. COAL PLAY raced close up inside and failed to respond when asked. ACTIN GOOD chased three wide throughout and tired. RESEARCHER settled off the pace, raced off the inside, moved up a bit while three wide entering the far turn and then failed to respond.
