LUCKY JAMES challenged for the lead nearing the quarter pole, reached the front in the stretch and responded to urging while drawing clear. HOP SKIP AND AWAY raced near the inside on the turn, eased out in upper stretch and closed well late. WHO'S THE COWBOY raced four wide into the lane and was gaining late. UNWRITTEN set the pace, saved ground and weakened in the drive. ORIGINAL SIN close up early and between rivals passing the half mile pole, dropped back some and was four wide into the stretch then lacked the needed response. TRUEAMERICANSPIRIT saved ground into the turn, raced in the three path into the lane and weakened in the drive. A DYNAMITE TIME chased near the inside and weakened into the lane. EVENINGS END moved in on the backstretch, saved ground on the turn and lacked the needed rally. HOBBITONTHEROCKS lacked a response.
