MIDNIGHT NOTES raced three wide early, stalked outside, bid three wide on the far turn, took over and drew clear. BROOMER was outrun early, made a four wide run on the far turn and finished well. CACAWAY raced off the pace, bid three wide on the far turn and rallied mildly inside. PAUPER'S QUEEN raced off the pace, moved up three wide at the quarter pole and was outkicked. FAVORITE KETCH saved ground, swung wide for the drive and lacked a rally. SMART PHONE raced between foes on the clubhouse turn, made a four wide bid on the far turn and tired. SAMBUCCA STEVE vied inside, dueled and faded. SOUP A' FLEET vied three wide early, dueled outside and faded. DEMOGRAPHIC TREND vied between rivals early, then chased and faded.
