COCKTAIL CORNER raced quickly clear setting the pace and was set down to extend her lead through the stretch. ONE UP was hustled along toward the inside then dueled to maintain place. ALWAYS ON THE GO chased the pace widest on the backstretch, came in a bit on the turn then was under a drive through the stretch but was outfinished for place. CLOUD CITY was steadied lacking room near the rail on the turn, angled out entering the stretch and finished evenly. SPLASHING ROSE showed no speed and offered no rally. GLAMOUR TOUR chased the early pace then faded on the turn. NOBLE SEARCH chased the pace to mid turn and was through from there. BEST LAID PLANS chased the pace near the rail, was steadied into the turn, angled to the outside on the turn then had no rally.
