SAM HILLIC was well placed inside, came through a tight spot on the rail in upper stretch, dug in determinedly inside and prevailed. ALKE JOHN raced off the pace, advanced on the turn, split rivals in the three path in midstretch and closed willingly outside. RUNAWAY JIM stalked the pace, bid on the turn, gained a short lead and dug in gamely between foes late. KNACK raced off the pace inside, came three wide into the lane and was outkicked. BATTER UP brushed with MOMMA'S HAPPY at the start, stalked two wide, came four wide into the lane and lacked a rally. MOMMA'S HAPPY was brushed at the start, set the pace on the inside and gave way. DEPUTY DILLON raced three wide on the backstretch and did not factor.
