YO KOFFY chased outside, bid three wide at the quarter pole, dug in gamely between rivals and got the nod on the wire. START THE PARTY raced three wide on the turn, came four wide into the lane, closed gamely outside and just missed. GOTOGO BYE dueled inside, inched away and dug in gamely through the stretch. WAR AND THUNDER raced off the pace, came three wide into the lane and closed belatedly outside. HOLY CRUSADER raced off the pace inside, two path into the stretch and rallied mildly inside. HOWELLING WIND raced between rivals early, saved ground on the turn and lacked a rally. RASS STONE dueled two wide and tired. KYLIES WILDCARD raced inside and faded.
