### Footnotes

AGUALINDA had a three wide trip, was making a bid turning for home, then was slammed by a fallen rival, got back on track and rallied late to get up. REPOSSEE raced between rivals, rallied near the inside entering the stretch, inherited the lead and was caught in the final strides. PAULSBOURBONBABY raced four wide early, then vied three wide, dueled on the far turn, was slammed by a fallen rival at the top of the stretch, recovered and stayed on to earn the show. HOLY DEFREERE was outrun early and passed tired foes. CIRCULAR RHYTHM dueled inside and tired. TOUGH ENOUGH did not factor. MS. JUDY dueled between rivals, dropped back, raced five wide into the stretch and then was checked hard to avoid the spill. YOUNGWILDANDFREE raced off the pace inside, was pulled up to avoid the fallen rider turning for home and eased in the stretch. NO VEGGIES raced off the pace, made a three wide bid on the turn, rallied to the front and then broke down at the three sixteenths pole hitting rivals. After a Stewards' Inquiry, the race was declared official.
