GAMBARU hung five wide into the clubhouse turn, challenged for the lead between rivals on the backstretch, chased a rival rounding the final turn then finished steadily and edged clear late. FREE AFRICA in the five path entering the clubhouse turn, moved up outside down the backstretch and reached the front, drew clear on the final turn then yielded in the drive. HERO'S DESTINY vied early inside, raced between rivals passing the quarter pole, raced a bit erratically in upper stretch then ducked out under left handed pressure at the furlong marker and held the show. FINANCIER got out some entering the clubhouse turn, chased and raced four wide turning for home then lacked the needed stretch response. KING CHIECA bumped and in tight entering the clubhouse turn, challenged on the backstretch, chased and tired through the lane. STONE HARBOR RICH four wide and between rivals into the first turn, lacked a rally. ONE HOT RUNNER saved ground and lacked a response. FUTURES BOOK vied early and weakened through the lane. SMARTIE LOUIE lacked a response.
