Footnotes

BARELY NOTHING saved ground early, advanced on the final turn and moved four wide passing the quarter pole then drew clear through the lane, a driving winner. BORN TO CUS never far back and just off the inside into the far turn, raced four wide into the lane and finished willingly while second best. ZOSOGOOD five wide into the clubhouse turn, tracked outside, lodged a three wide bid on the final turn and reached the front then weakened in the drive. R J'S PROSPECT saved ground into the far turn, raced three wide into the stretch and lacked a late response. CURRAGH (ARG) stumbled badly at the start nearly unseating the rider dropping well back. THEPOSSE'SAFTERME three wide early, vied inside, raced in the two path on the final turn and tired through the lane. BLACK TIE SPIRIT four wide into the clubhouse turn, vied early, raced along the rail entering the far turn and weakened through the lane.
