HERMOSILLO pressured the pace toward mid track, dug in to wear down the pacesetter passing the eighth pole then dug in with a strong hand ride to keep At The Disco at bay. AT THE DISCO chased the pace toward mid track, entered the stretch about the eight path then closed well for place while not good enough to take the winner. BANJO BROWN hustled to the lead while off the rail, set a pressured pace to the lane and continued in a duel to deep stretch before weakening. VESPARO came out awkwardly, showed no speed off the rail, angled out leaving the quarter pole and finished evenly. PLATINUM GENERAL chased the pace from the inside, remained a close factor to the top of the stretch then weakened toward the eighth pole. BIG DADDY WOLF became fractious unseating his rider at the gate, broke out, picked up the chase in mid track then showed no stretch response. FOUR SHORE, pinched back early, slowly made up ground toward the inside and finished evenly. NUCLEUS chased the early pace inside, angled out through the turn and came up empty in the stretch. DIVINE DAY broke inward making contact with Four Shore, checked sharply soon afterward then never factored. PROUD ANDRE was no factor inside. LAMBERTSON ROAD never factored while wide. COMICO showed brief outside speed and faded through the turn.
