FOR FILLIES AND MARES, THREE YEARS OLD AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$250 each, which should accompany the nomination and \$3,000 to pass the entry box with \$300,000 guaranteed which includes \$100,000 from the Breeders' Cup Fund for Cup nominees only. The host association's money to be divided 60% to the winning owner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Breeders' Cup Fund money correspondingly divided providing a Breeders' Cup nominee has finished in an awarded position. Any Breeders' Cup money not awarded reverts to the Fund. Three-Year-Olds: 118 lbs.; Older: 123 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade I or II Stake at a mile or over since November 1 allowed 2 lbs.; \$90,000 at a mile or over in 2006, 4 lbs.; \$60,000 since May 1, 2006, 6 lbs. The owner of the winner to receive a trophy from Breeders' Cup Limited. Closed Sunday, August 13, 2006 with 17 nominations.

Footnotes

PROMENADE GIRL set the pace under a firm hold just off the rail, felt pressure nearing the quarter pole, came out slightly taking the runner-up out with her leaving the final turn, dueled inside from the top of the stretch, briefly gave up the lead passing the sixteenth pole but dug in determinedly to recover through the closing yards. ROUND POND rated just off the early pace three deep, pulled alongside the early leaders three wide into the backstretch, dropped back to remain in a stalking position to the final turn, started her drive toward the quarter pole, was carried out entering the lane, dueled to a short brief lead passing the sixteenth pole then outfinished in the ensuing yards. LA REASON rated back off the rail, angled out entering the lane and finished evenly to show. LEXI STAR rated close to the pace two deep while briefly between horses, gave chase into the final turn then had nothing left in the stretch. FRIEL'S FOR REAL , never far back from the early pace in mid track, was widest entering the stretch and weakened drifting in.
