IMPRESSIVE TIME took over on the turn, drew clear and widened into midstretch under pressure then remained well clear. COURAGE TO BE well placed early, lodged a bid on the turn and was second best. DANGER ANGEL raced along the rail into the stretch and lacked the needed late response. DEFRERE'S CODE saved ground on the turn, raced between rivals passing the eighth pole and lacked the needed response. BATTERING RAM broke in, saved ground into the turn, moved out and gained some late. A J NUGGET raced off the inside turning for home and lacked the needed stretch response. GUERRIER chased outside and also lacked a stretch response. RINGO MAN lacked a rally. RIDIN SHOTGUN failed to menace. CHANGE FOR GOLD set the early pace inside, moved off the rail on the turn and tired through the lane.
