TACTICAL WEAPON set a moderate pace, saved ground and dug in gamely to prevail. WALTZING WITH BLUE broke out and bumped at the start, lodged a three wide bid on the final turn, raced four wide into the lane and finished gamely while just missing. LAUREATE CONDUCTOR bumped at the start, saved ground to the lane, stayed inside and also finished gamely. KING CARTER up close early, saved ground turning for home, raced between rivals late and finished willingly. BEST ACTOR never far back and just off the inside turning for home, raced in some traffic in upper stretch then needed more late. EVER A FRIEND well placed early, was asked for run while three wide on the final turn and lacked the needed response while in a bit close briefly nearing the sixteenth pole. SCATTER THE TAK tracked early, chased on the final turn and was not good enough. CREW near the inside into the far turn, was in the three path into the lane and lacked the needed rally. NIGHTSCAPE broke out some then a bit rank briefly early inside, trailed and lacked a rally.
