Footnotes

TRULUCK chased in the second flight of horses off the rail going into the first turn, edged closer the front runner four wide on the last turn, was put to a fierce drive four wide entering the stretch and drew clear in the final furlong under a steady drive. ROCK AND ROLL was close up to the pace three wide early, remained in close attendance to SUPER MARFALOUS for the backside run, made a decisive bid for the lead entering the far turn three wide, took the lead midway around the turn, was overtaken at the furlong pole and was no match for the winner but was the best of the rest. SIFTAWAY bobbed at start, stalked along the rail under a hard hold, made a bid for the lead three wide on the last turn, was in behind horses midway on the final turn, was caught four wide into the stretch with the leaders and couldn't quicken with the top two late but was the best of the balance. TAMARILLO was close up to the pace off the rail early, applied pressure to the pacemaker for the backside journey and tired on the final turn. SUPER MARFALOUS was the early pacemaker along the inside, took pace pressure down the backside and tired on the last turn. ESPERERO was no factor.
