METROLOGY a bit slow early, gradually advanced down the backstretch, lodged a three wide bid on the final turn and vied for the lead then drew out late. MINUTE was jostled between rivals at the start, lodged a bid on the final turn, raced three wide into the lane and finished steadily while clear for the place. VINNIE forced in at the start, tracked down the backstretch, challenged between rivals on the final turn and battled into midstretch then weakened late. BRIMSTONE AND FIRE raced outside, was four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. BARBERSHOP broke out some and lacked a bid. WHODAT SAY WHODAT broke in, set the early pace and had little left turning for home. TIZ A THEME stumbled at the start then knocked sideways and steadied leaving the gate, chased into the far turn and weakened. DISCO DEVIN bumped a rival at the start, chased early and gave way on the final turn then lost contact in the stretch.
