**Footnotes**

KIPLING tracked the leaders three wide early, moved in tandem with MAX REGENT for the backside run to engage the early pacemaker, dueled with that foe on the turn, turned that foe away entering the stretch, got a fresh challenge from MOST INNOVATIVE through the stretch and just hung on gamely in the final furlong. MOST INNOVATIVE well back early, circled the field four wide on the turn and couldn't get by the winner in the stretch. ROUGH GUIDE outran early, split foes with a decisive bid for the lead three wide on the last turn, came out four wide into the stretch and ran evenly through the stretch. MAX REGENT held a forward position along the inside early, moved up nicely with the winner to engaged the early pacemaker for the backside run, applied more pressure on the turn and tired late. CODE FOUND chased along the rail early, was roused on the rail on the final turn and failed to fire late. ALASKAN SPIRIT was the early pacemaker along the rail, took pressure entering the backstretch and relented at the half mile pole.
