SURE CURE was hustled along early on, settled into stride just off the early leader, dueled with All Mine through the stretch and edged away from her in late strides. ALL MINE stalked the pace, was boxed in into and through the turn, angled out for room entering the stretch, dueled to the late stretch and grudgingly let go. EVA'SASSY raced off the pace, made a bid from the middle of the turn and close on the outside through the stretch. SCOBEBY GIRL was jostled leaving the chute, advanced to the lead, was clear into the stretch, caught near the eighth pole then tired inside. LASTING LOOK chased the pace, dropped back through the turn then tired in the stretch. DELFINIA had no response to urging.
