BREADKNIFE advanced to the early lead rating the pace, was hooked from the top of the stretch and remained gamely in control under a steady drive. SALLY Q had a brief lead out of the gate before the first call then stalked the pace through the turn, challenged the winner remaining at her neck through the stretch but hung late. PLEASER angled in early racing just off the pace, was between horses then altered course entering the stretch then stayed on in the drive. ANYTHING FOR YOU showed no speed, angled to the outside entering the stretch, offered a mild bid and finished evenly. CUPID'S COMET chased the pace toward the outside, was five wide through the turn then empty in the stretch. REBUY stumbled to her knees at the break and was no factor afterward.
