STORMY SIEGE raced five wide turning for home, reached KNIGHT OF DARKNESS leaving the furlong grounds then bested that one to the wire. KNIGHT OF DARKNESS three deep early, moved to the lead nearing the top of the lane, drew clear in upper stretch and continued on gamely. FUMPH AROUND always a factor, advanced some into upper stretch and tired in the drive. COUP DE GRACE raced just off the rail on the turn and lacked a solid stretch response. TAP DAY raced outside turning for home and lacked a solid rally. SORVEL trailed and lacked a rally. POKER GAME advanced inside through the opening stages, saved ground and vied for the lead then tired through the lane. DELAWARE RIVER between foes early, vied for the lead and tired through the stretch.
