UNFORGETTABLE MAX rated the pace off the rail then drew off through the stretch under minimal urging, ridden out. WESTON FIELD, unhurriedly, bid angling widest on the final turn, angled in closing through the stretch and was just up inside for place. DEUX MILLE rated close in the three path, gave chase through the home turn then outfinished for place the final strides. CROSSING CREEK rated off the pace inside, gave chase into the final turn, was eased out for the drive and outfinished in the place duel. VOW steadied inside lacking room at the three quarter pole, rated off the pace inside then faded nearing the final turn. SEATTLE SURPRISE and MOUNTAIN CREEK were outrun. DOUBLE CHOCOLATE rated close to the early pace outside then gave way on the final turn.
