VICARIOUS SARA well placed and between rivals entering the far turn, challenged for the lead nearing the top of the lane and responded gamely to prevail while lugging in some. MY FRIEND TERRI stalked the early leader, moved to the front nearing the quarter pole and responded gamely in the drive then yielded grudgingly. ISBELL AMBIEL bothered at the start, was gaining late from the outside. WON JENELLE broke outward then steadied early, offered a late from out in the course. IRVING'S BABY bumped at the start, saved ground while in a good striking position then lacked the needed stretch response. DRUMSTICKS posted the early fractions, saved ground and weakened in the drive. MICHELLE'S TATALA lacked a rally. SUNDA broke a bit slowly then lacked a rally. GAYLE'S GLORY loomed a threat from the outside into the far turn and gradually gave way.
