

MARESHA was rated back toward the outside, started her bid three wide on the turn, was eased out for room in midstretch, dueled through the final sixteenth and edged ahead in the final yards. MISS MARNI stalked the lead just outside the early pacesetter, took a short lead entering the stretch, dueled gamely to the wire but was outfinished through the final yards. AL MAX DINER rated the pace under a firm hold just off the rail, dueled from the top of the stretch while between horses then reluctantly yielded in the final seventy yards. BOLD WORLD rated just off the pace on the inside, briefly lost momentum and ducked out entering the stretch, came back to the inside dueling through midstretch then leveled out the final sixteenth. REDHEAD RIOT stumbled at the start then bobbed another stride out, advanced to contention on the outside then weakened widest through the stretch.
