WITHLAPATIENCE hustled up for position just off the rail, raced well reserved to the top of the lane, was pressured for run from that point then relaxed the final seventy yards. MERCURYNA rated off the pace inside, bid into the final turn, was no match for the winner but clearly second best. VICTORY WAY kept close about the four path, picked up the chase nearing the final turn and finished evenly. NAUTICAL AGENT dropped back unhurriedly while saving ground, started a drive into the final turn, angled out toward the quarter pole, entered the stretch widest and finished evenly. JETTERINA, unhurried in mid track, bid mildly nearing the final turn but proved empty in the stretch. PURRRFECT CRIME rated off the pace about the three path, gave chase nearing the final turn then weakened at the quarter pole. COLONIAL PROMISE steadied briefly at the start then showed no speed. ENCHANTING MURIEL, outside, tired after half.
