WILLI VON LOON close up early, moved to the front three wide nearing the quarter pole, drew well clear into midstretch then was ridden out until nearing the wire. TIMELESS CLASSIC well placed early, lodged a bid on the final turn and was second best. ROAD NOT TRAVELED lodged a bid on the last turn and was along for the show award. LOCKUP broke in some, saved ground to the lane, was angled in leaving the eighth pole for a clear path then offered a mild response. PARK AVENUE raced four wide turning for home and offered a mild late gain. HERMOSILLO vied for the early lead outside a rival and weakened in the drive. CAPACIOUS lodged a bid on the final turn, raced near the inside turning for home and weakened in the drive. OK THIS WAY saved ground and dueled for the early lead then tired in the drive. MIZZOU TIGER well placed early, saved ground into the far turn and gave way.
