VICTORY RIDE held a narrow advantage through the early fractions, drew clear in upper stretch then was ridden out. TAP DANCE pressed the pace from along the inside, was angled out nearing the furlong marker after losing contact with the top one then was second best. COCKTAILSANDREAMS raced close up from the outside into upper stretch and weakened. GAELIC BAY trailed and lacked a rally. A claim of foul by the rider of COCKTAILSANDREAMS against TAP DANCE for interference nearing the eighth pole was not allowed.
