ROCK ISLAND SALAMI was hustled up setting a pressured pace mid track, drew clear entering the stretch, widened slightly and held well with steady encouragement. HEY CHUB broke through prior the start, pressured the early pace about the four path, altered course when changing leads toward midstretch then picked up some late momentum. SPECIAL JUDGE pressured the pace about the three path, dropped back into the stretch then weakened with a furlong to go. CHEROKEE HONOR was shuffled back early, chased the pace from the inside then weakened drifting out. GOLDEN GATOR showed no speed outside and offered no rally. OTTAWA CHIEF chased the early pace toward the outside, saved ground on the turn and was empty in the stretch. SECOND COLLECTION never factored. EL PROGRESO chased the pace from the inside, steadied nearing the turn, bore out through the turn then tired.
