ICY ATLANTIC saved ground into the far turn, moved off the inside turning for home, eased out in upper stretch and finished gamely to prevail. TOUCHED BY MADNESS tracked the early leader, moved to the front on the final turn, responded gamely in the drive and yielded grudgingly. BARON VON TAP in good position along the inside, raced between rivals inside the furlong marker and also finished gamely. AMENABLE well placed early and outside a rival, finished willingly while not good enough. GIMME CREDIT never far back and along the inside entering the far turn, was asked on the final bend and lacked the needed response while gaining some late. SHAKE THE BANK broke a bit awkwardly, set the early pace, saved ground and weakened in the drive. PRESIOUS PASSION broke a bit slowly, raced outside down the backstretch and lacked the needed rally.
